## A bill to be entitled

An act relating to collegiate license plates;
amending s. 320.08056 , F.S.; exempting a collegiate specialty plate from the requirement to maintain minimum sales of 1,000 or more until the plate has been offered for a specified period; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 320.08056,
Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
320.08056 Specialty license plates.--
(8) (a) The department must discontinue the issuance of an approved specialty license plate if the number of valid specialty plate registrations falls below 1,000 plates for at least 12 consecutive months. However, this requirement does not apply to a colleqiate license plate issued under s. 320.08058(3) until the plate has been offered 8 years. A warning letter shall be mailed to the sponsoring organization following the first month in which the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is below 1,000 plates.
(b) The department is authorized to discontinue the issuance of a specialty license plate and distribution of associated annual use fee proceeds if the organization no longer exists, if the organization has stopped providing services that are authorized to be funded from the annual use fee proceeds, or pursuant to an organizational recipient's request. Organizations are required to notify the department immediately to stop all warrants for plate sales if any of the conditions in this section exist, and must meet the

during a fiscal year.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
