A bill to be entitled

An act relating to drug trafficking; amending s. 893.135, F.S.; providing for the aggregation of the weights of certain controlled substances in determining the punishment for a drug-trafficking offense; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 893.135, Florida Statutes, to read:

893.135 Trafficking; mandatory sentences; suspension or reduction of sentences; conspiracy to engage in trafficking.--

(8) The weights of separate controlled substances that are sold, purchased, manufactured, delivered, or brought into this state, or are actually or constructively possessed by a specific person in a series of violations of this chapter, committed pursuant to one scheme or course of conduct over a period of not more than 30 days, may be aggregated in determining the punishment for an offense under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
