Helmets purchased prior to October 1, 25 2006, and meeting standards of the American National Standards 26 Institute (ANSI Z 90.4 Bicycle Helmet Standards), the standards 27 of the Snell Memorial Foundation (1984 Standard for Protective Headgear for Use in Bicycling), or any other nationally 28 29 recognized standards for bicycle helmets adopted by the department may continue to be worn by riders or passengers until 30 January 1, 2010. As used in this subsection, the term 31 32 "passenger" includes a child who is riding in a trailer or 33 semitrailer attached to a bicycle.

34 Every bicycle in use between sunset and sunrise shall (8) 35 be equipped with a lamp on the front exhibiting a white light 36 visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the front and a lamp and reflector on the rear each exhibiting a red light 37 visible from a distance of 600 feet to the rear. A bicycle or 38 39 its rider may be equipped with lights or reflectors in addition 40 to those required by this section. Law enforcement officers may issue a bicycle safety brochure and a verbal warning to a 41 42 bicycle rider who violates this subsection. A bicycle rider who 43 violates this subsection may be issued a citation by a law 44 enforcement officer and assessed a fine for a pedestrian 45 violation, as provided in s. 318.18. The court shall dismiss the 46 charge against a bicycle rider for a first violation of this subsection upon proof of purchase and installation of the proper 47 48 lighting equipment. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2006. 49
