The results furnished to the Mayor of Broward County, each county commissioner, and the county auditor shall include 19 the same results as furnished to the county property 20 21 appraiser, such as all statistical and analytical measures 22 computed for the real property assessment roll as a whole, the 23 personal property assessment roll as a whole, and, independently for the real property classes and subclasses 2.4 studied, results of any audit or review of procedures used by 25 26 the county property appraiser, and, if Broward County is not being studied in the current year, any value-weighted mean 27 2.8 levels of assessment projected for that year pursuant to state 29 law. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 31 law.
