the following **substitute for amendment** (412394):

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. (1) The Agency for Health Care
Administration, in consultation with the Office of Insurance
Regulation, shall conduct a study evaluating the medical
necessity, efficacy, and costs associated with mandating
health insurers and health maintenance organizations to
provide coverage for cranial skull molding orthotics and other
therapies used in the treatment of deformational or positional
plagiocephaly. The agency and office shall evaluate whether or
not gaps in coverage currently exist in the small and large
group insurance markets for medically necessary care and
treatment of plagiocephaly. The agency shall provide
information concerning the types of benefits, including the
cost of such benefits, provided to Medicaid recipients for the
treatment of plagiocephaly, and the demographic
