When 25 law enforcement or correctional agency personnel assigned the responsibility of investigating the complaint prepare an 26 27 investigative report or summary, regardless of form, the person preparing the report shall, at the time the report is completed: 28 29 (a) Verify pursuant to s. 92.525 that the contents of the report are true and accurate based upon the person's personal 30 knowledge, information, and belief. 31 (b) Include the following statement, sworn and subscribed 32 33 to pursuant to s. 92.525: "I, the undersigned, do hereby swear, under penalty of 34 35 perjury, that, to the best of my personal knowledge, information, and belief, I have not knowingly or willfully 36 37 deprived, or allowed another to deprive, the subject of the 38 investigation of any of the rights contained in ss. 112.532 and 39 112.533, Florida Statutes." 40 The requirements of paragraphs (a) and (b) shall be completed 41 42 prior to the determination as to whether to proceed with disciplinary action or to file disciplinary charges. This 43 subsection does not preclude the Criminal Justice Standards and 44 45 Training Commission from exercising its authority under chapter 943. 46 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. 47
