Section 943.17001, Florida Statutes, is 13 created to read: 943.17001 Correctional probation officers; provision 14 of standardized firearm and ammunition .-- Upon completion of 15 training, certification, and approval as a correctional 16 17 probation officer, the Department of Corrections shall provide 18 to any correctional probation officer who chooses to carry a firearm a standardized semiautomatic firearm as designated by 19 department rule, and, for the duration of the correctional 20 21 probation officer's employment, standardized ammunition as designated by department rule for the semiautomatic firearm 22 23 issued to the correctional probation officer. If a correctional probation officer elects to no longer carry a 2.4 firearm, changes the type of firearm he or she chooses to 25 carry, or is no longer employed by the department, he or she 26 27 must return the firearm and any unused ammunition issued by 2.8 the department. The department has the authority to adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to implement the 29 provisions of this section. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006. 31
