(a) The school board shall be responsible for 25 providing the appropriate instructional, support, and 26 administrative staff and textbooks, materials, and supplies. 27 28 The school district may also agree to operate or contract for the operation of a before-school and after-school program 29 using the donated facilities. 30 31 (b) The host business shall provide the appropriate 4
