29 (7) A community pharmacy licensed under this chapter which 30 only receives and transfers prescriptions for dispensing by 31 another pharmacy may transfer a prescription for a medicinal 32 drug listed in Schedule II under chapter 893. The pharmacy 33 receiving the prescription may ship, mail, or deliver into this 34 state, in any manner, the dispensed Schedule II medicinal drug 35 under the following conditions:
