Section 2. Section 372.87, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

372.87 License fee; renewal, revocation. -- The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission is hereby authorized and empowered to issue a license or permit for the keeping, possessing, or exhibiting of regulated poisonous or venomous reptiles, upon payment of an annual fee of \$100 and upon assurance that all of the provisions of ss. 372.86-372.91 and such other reasonable rules and regulations as said commission may prescribe will be fully complied with in all respects. 372.88 Bond required, amount.--No person, party, firm, or corporation shall exhibit to the public either with or without charge, or admission fee any regulated poisonous or venomous reptile without having first posted a good and sufficient bond in writing in the penal sum of \$10,000 \$1,000 payable to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Governor of the state, and the Governor's successors in office, conditioned that such exhibitor will indemnify and 2 \$1,000
