1-181-07 1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to health insurance; requiring health benefit plans, as defined, to offer 3 coverage for prostate cancer early detection 4 5 screening for certain men; providing an б effective date. 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 8 9 10 Section 1. (1)(a) A health benefit plan that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on or after January 11 12 1, 2008, which provides coverage to men age 40 or older must 13 offer coverage for annual screening for prostate cancer for such men, according to the prostate cancer early detection 14 guidelines of the National Comprehensive Cancer Network. The 15 coverage may not be subject to plan deductibles. 16 17 (b) The coverage for prostate cancer screening shall 18 consist, at a minimum, of the following tests: 1. Prostate-specific antigen blood test; and 19 2. Digital rectal examination. 20 21 (c) If a medical practitioner recommends that an insured, subscriber, or enrollee undergo a prostate-specific 22 23 antigen blood test, coverage may not be denied because that person previously had a digital rectal exam and the exam 2.4 25 results were negative. (2) The benefits required by this section do not limit 26 27 diagnostic benefits otherwise allowable under a health benefit 28 plan. (3) As used in this section, the term "health benefit 29 plan" means group hospital or medical insurance coverage, a 30 not-for-profit hospital or medical service or indemnity plan, 31

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a prepaid health plan, a health maintenance organization plan, 1 a preferred provider organization plan, a state or municipal 2 3 employee health insurance plan, a program funded under Title 4 XIX of the Social Security Act or other publicly funded 5 program, a Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement, or an б employee self-insured plan, except as exempt under federal 7 ERISA provisions. The term does not include short-term, 8 accident, fixed indemnity, or specified disease policies, 9 disability income contracts, limited benefit or credit 10 disability insurance, workers' compensation insurance, automobile medical payment insurance, or insurance under which 11 12 benefits are payable without regard to fault and which is 13 required by law to be included in a liability insurance policy or equivalent self-insurance. 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2008. 15 16 17 18 SENATE SUMMARY Requires health benefit plans that offer coverage to 19 persons age 40 or older to include diagnostic screening benefits for prostate cancer to such men.
