Section 1. (1) For the 2007-2008 fiscal year, the sums of \$415,291 in recurring funds and \$52,430 in nonrecurring funds are appropriated from the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund of the Department of Financial Services to the Division of Insurance Fraud within the department and 10 full-time equivalent positions and associated salary rate of 342,500 are authorized. This appropriation is for the purposes of investigations of motor vehicle insurance fraud by the Division of Insurance Fraud or the Department of Financial Services pursuant to s. 626.989, Florida Statutes.

For the 2007-2008 fiscal year, the sum of \$750,000 in recurring funds is appropriated from the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund and divided into six equal amounts, each equal amount to be allocated to the State Attorneys for the 4th, 6th, 9th, 13th, 15th, and 17th Circuits to establish and fund an additional assistant state attorney position in each circuit for the purpose of prosecuting cases of motor vehicle insurance fraud.
