A bill to be entitled

An act relating to employee benefits; providing for the resolution of certain collective bargaining issues at impasse between the State of Florida and certified bargaining units of state employees; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. All economic collective bargaining issues at impasse for the 2007-2008 fiscal year between the State of Florida and the legal representatives of the certified bargaining units for state employees shall be resolved pursuant to the instructions provided in the General Appropriations Act and the relevant provisions of any legislation enacted to implement the General Appropriations Act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides for certain collective bargaining issues at impasse between the state and certified bargaining units of state employees to be resolved as provided in the General Appropriations Act.
