Kidcare program to be indispensable to providing health 1 2 benefits for children of modest means, NOW, THEREFORE, 3 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 4 5 6 That the Legislature urges the members of the Florida 7 delegation to the United States Congress to ensure that the 8 Congress reauthorizes the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) to continue to provide federal funding for the 9 Florida Kidcare program. 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature urges the 11 Governor to work with the Florida delegation to ensure that 12 13 SCHIP is reauthorized in a timely manner. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature urges the Governor to provide the assistance necessary to identify and 15 enroll children who qualify for Medicaid or the Florida 16 17 Kidcare program. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature proclaims that all components of state government should work together 19 with educators, health care providers, social workers, and 20 parents to ensure that all available public and private 21 22 assistance for providing health benefits to uninsured children 23 in this state be used to the maximum extent possible. 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the 25 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the 26 United States House of Representatives, and to each member of 27 28 the Florida delegation to the United States Congress. 29 30 31
