The agency and office 18 shall evaluate whether gaps in coverage currently exist in the 19 20 small and large group insurance markets for medically necessary care and treatment of plagiocephaly. The agency shall provide 21 information concerning the types of benefits, including the cost 22 of such benefits, provided to Medicaid recipients for the 23 24 treatment of plagiocephaly, and the demographic characteristics of such Medicaid recipients. The Department of Health shall 25 coordinate with the agency to provide such information 26 27 concerning coverage and costs provided to children having plagiocephaly who are enrolled in the Children's Medical 28

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29 Services Program. The agency, in consultation with the office, may 30 (2)contract with an actuary who is a member of the American Academy 31 32 of Actuaries and any other person or persons who have an 33 extensive background in health insurance for the purpose of assisting the agency in evaluating the medically necessity, 34 efficacy, and costs of such coverage. The agency shall report 35 its findings and recommendations related to mandating insurance 36 37 coverage for the treatment of plagiocephaly to the President of 38 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no 39 later than January 1, 2008. Section 2. For the 2007-2008 fiscal year, the sum of 40 41 \$25,000 is appropriated in nonrecurring funds from the Insurance 42 Regulatory Trust Fund to the Office of Insurance Regulation for 43 the purpose of funding the study conducted by the Agency for Health Care Administration as provided in this act. 44 45 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

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
