(f) The term "pending litigation" includes matters that are the subject of notice given to a governmental entity pursuant to s. 768.28 with respect to which a lawsuit has not yet been filed and matters about which the governmental entity is contemplating litigation. б Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. SENATE SUMMARY Requires that the transcript of a meeting between officers of a governmental entity and an attorney which deals with pending litigation and which is exempted from statutory requirements relating to public meetings and records be made public if the governmental entity determines not to commence the litigation. Defines the term "pending litigation" for purposes of the exemption. 2.4
