The Committee on Commerce (Lynn) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 2, lines 21-30, delete those lines

and insert: certificate may have an expiration date of not less than 3 years if it is provided as a charitable contribution when no consideration is given to the issuer by the consumer, and not less than 1 year if it is provided as a benefit pursuant to an employee-incentive program, consumer-loyalty program, or promotional program when no consideration is given to the issuer by the consumer and the expiration date is prominently disclosed in writing to the consumer at the time it is provided. In addition, a gift certificate may have an expiration date if it is provided as part of a larger package related to a convention, conference, vacation, or sporting or fine arts event having a limited duration so long as the majority of the value paid by the recipient is attributable to the convention, conference, vacation, or event.
