Certification by a doctor and 20 21 an optometrist of total and permanent disability due to 22 blindness may be deemed to meet the requirements of subsection 23 (3). Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2008. 2.4 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY 2.8 Authorizes a licensed optometrist to certify a person as totally and permanently disabled solely due to legal 29 blindness for purposes of claiming an exemption from ad valorem taxes. 30 31
