certificate that is not in strict compliance with this subsection and the rules is liable for and shall pay the tax. The department may adopt rules to administer this subsection. (d) Feeds.--Feeds for poultry, ostriches, and livestock, including racehorses and dairy cows, are exempt. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. SENATE SUMMARY Repeals the sales tax exemption for ostrich feed.
