(2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301, Florida Statutes, and 22 23 under s. 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust 2.4 fund at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for 2.5 26 carrying out the purposes of the trust fund. 27 (3) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2), Article III 2.8 of the State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2011. Before its 29 scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as 30 provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. 31
