Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 1003.57, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 14 1003.57 Exceptional students instruction .--15 (1) Each district school board shall provide for an 16 17 appropriate program of special instruction, facilities, and services for exceptional students as prescribed by the State 18 Board of Education as acceptable, including provisions that: 19 (b) The district school board provide the special 20 21 instruction, classes, and services, either within the district 22 school system, in cooperation with other district school 23 systems, or through contractual arrangements with approved private schools or community facilities that meet standards 2.4 established by the commissioner. If an exceptional student 25 26 with a disability receives educational services in a school 27 district other than his or her assigned school district, the 2.8 cost of providing such services shall be borne by the school district in which the parent of the student maintains 29 residence or, if the student no longer resides with the 30 parent, the cost of providing such services shall be borne by 31

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1 the school district in which the parent maintained residence 2 at the time the student last resided with the parent. Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 1003.58, Florida 3 Statutes, is amended to read: 4 5 1003.58 Students in residential care facilities.--Each 6 district school board shall provide educational programs 7 according to rules of the State Board of Education to students 8 who reside in residential care facilities operated by the Department of Children and Family Services or the Agency for 9 10 Persons with Disabilities. (3) The district school board shall have full and 11 12 complete authority in the matter of the assignment and 13 placement of such students in educational programs. The parent of an exceptional student shall have the same due process 14 rights as are provided under s. 1003.57(1)(e). If the 15 residential care facility in which an exceptional student with 16 17 a disability resides is located in a school district other 18 than the student's assigned school district, the cost of providing educational services to such student shall be borne 19 by the school district in which the parent maintained 2.0 21 residence at the time the student last resided with the 22 parent. 23 Notwithstanding the provisions herein, the educational program 2.4 at the Marianna Sunland Center in Jackson County shall be 25 26 operated by the Department of Education, either directly or 27 through grants or contractual agreements with other public or 2.8 duly accredited educational agencies approved by the 29 Department of Education. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. 30 31

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
