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Barcode 075352 prepared on a consolidated basis must include a columnar consolidating or combining worksheet that must be filed with the statement and must comply with the following: (a) Amounts shown on the consolidated audited financial statement must be shown on the worksheet; (b) Amounts for each entity must be stated separately; and (c) Explanations of consolidating and eliminating entries must be included. Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 626.9913, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

626.9913 Viatical settlement provider license continuance; annual report; fees; deposit .--

(2) Annually, on or before March 1, the viatical settlement provider licensee shall file a statement containing information the commission requires and shall pay to the office a license fee in the amount of \$500. After December 31, 2007, the annual statement shall include an annual audited financial statement of the viatical settlement provider statements prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles by an independent certified public accountant covering a 12-month period ending on a day falling  $\underline{\text{during}}$   $\underline{\text{as of}}$  the last  $\underline{\text{6 months}}$   $\underline{\text{day}}$  of the preceding calendar year. If the audited financial statement has not been completed, however, the licensee shall include in its annual statement an unaudited financial statement for the preceding calendar year and an affidavit from an officer of the licensee stating that the audit has not been completed. In this event, the licensee shall submit the audited statement on or before June 1.
