Subsection (16) of section 218.415, Florida 13 Statutes, is amended to read: 218.415 Local government investment 14 policies.--Investment activity by a unit of local government 15 must be consistent with a written investment plan adopted by 16 17 the governing body, or in the absence of the existence of a governing body, the respective principal officer of the unit 18 of local government and maintained by the unit of local 19 government or, in the alternative, such activity must be 20 21 conducted in accordance with subsection (17). Any such unit 22 of local government shall have an investment policy for any 23 public funds in excess of the amounts needed to meet current expenses as provided in subsections (1)-(16), or shall meet 2.4 the alternative investment guidelines contained in subsection 25 (17). Such policies shall be structured to place the highest 26 27 priority on the safety of principal and liquidity of funds. 2.8 The optimization of investment returns shall be secondary to the requirements for safety and liquidity. Each unit of local 29 government shall adopt policies that are commensurate with the 30 nature and size of the public funds within its custody. 31

20	<u>(q)(f)</u> Securities of, or other interests in, any
21	open-end or closed-end management-type investment company or
22	investment trust registered under the Investment Company Act
23	of 1940, 15 U.S.C. ss. 80a-1 et seq., as amended from time to
24	time, provided that the portfolio of such investment company
25	or investment trust is limited to obligations of the United
26	States Government or any agency or instrumentality thereof and
27	to repurchase agreements fully collateralized by such United
28	States Government obligations, and provided that such
29	investment company or investment trust takes delivery of such
30	collateral either directly or through an authorized custodian.
