This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. 2.4 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY 2.8 Prohibits the owner of a self-service storage facility or self-contained storage unit from attempting to enforce a 29 lien against a tenant who is a military servicemember on active duty outside the United States or for 90 days 30 after such overseas active duty is completed, if such tenant has given the owner written notice of such duty. 31
