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18	Section 1. Section 608.406, Florida Statutes, is amended

21	(1) A limited liability company name:
22	(a) Must contain the words "limited liability company <del>" or</del>
23	<del>"limited company</del> ," <del>or</del> the <u>abbreviation</u> <del>abbreviations</del> "L.L.C. <del>" or</del>
24	<del>"L.C.</del> ," or the <u>designation</u> <del>designations</del> "LLC" <del>or "LC"</del> as the
25	last words of the name of every limited liability company formed
26	under the provisions of this chapter. The word "limited" may be
27	abbreviated as "Ltd.," and the word "company" may be abbreviated
28	as "Co." Omission of the words "limited liability company <del>" or</del>
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29 "limited company," the <u>abbreviation</u> abbreviations "L.L.C." or 30 "L.C.," or the <u>designation</u> designations "LLC" or "LC" in the use 31 of the name of the limited liability company shall render any 32 person who knowingly participates in the omission, or knowingly 33 acquiesces in the omission, liable for any indebtedness, damage, 34 or liability caused by the omission.

(b) May not contain language stating or implying that the
limited liability company is organized for a purpose other than
that permitted in this chapter and its articles of organization.

38 (c) May not contain language stating or implying that the 39 limited liability company is connected with a state or federal 40 government agency or a corporation or other entity chartered 41 under the laws of the United States.

The name of the limited liability company must be 42 (2) distinguishable on the records of the Division of Corporations 43 of the Department of State, except for fictitious name 44 registrations filed pursuant to s. 865.09 and general 45 partnership registrations filed pursuant to s. 620.8105; 46 47 however, a limited liability company may register under a name 48 that is not otherwise distinguishable on the records of the 49 Division of Corporations with written consent of the owner 50 entity provided the consent is filed with the Division of 51 Corporations at the time of registration of such name.

52 <u>(3)(2)</u> The name of the limited liability company shall be 53 filed with the Department of State for public notice only and 54 shall not alone create any presumption of ownership beyond that 55 which is created under the common law.
