This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. 10 STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN 11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR 12 Senate Bill 2544 13 Provides that for a life felony committed on or after 14 July 1, 2007, which is a person's third or subsequent conviction for lewd molestation by an adult against a 15 victim less than 12 years of age, the person shall be punished by a term of imprisonment for life. 16 17 Removes provisions from the original bill that amended the Dangerous Sexual Felony Offender Act and that provided for reclassification of the degree of and 18 mandatory minimum terms for person who have repeat 19 convictions for specified offenses. 20 21 22 23 2.4 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
