Section 400.6051, Florida Statutes, is 11 12 amended to read: 13 400.6051 Construction and renovation; requirements.--(1) The requirements for the construction and the 14 renovation of a hospice residential or inpatient facility or 15 unit must comply with the provisions of chapter 553 which 16 17 pertain to building construction standards, including plumbing, electrical code, glass, manufactured buildings, 18 accessibility for persons with disabilities, and the state 19 minimum building codes. The Agency for Health Care 20 21 Administration shall provide technical assistance to the 22 Florida Building Commission in updating the construction 23 standards of the Florida Building Code which govern hospice facilities. 2.4 (2) Upon request by the prospective licensee of an 25 inpatient hospice facility, the agency may provide an informal 26 27 review of a facility prior to construction in order to assist 2.8 the facility in complying with agency rules and this part. (3) The agency may charge a fee that is commensurate 29 with the cost of providing consultation under this section and 30 that is not refundable. 31
