The purpose of this act is to provide for the solemnization and memorialization of events and ceremonies 26 27 at secondary schools, and this act is not intended to advance 2.8 or endorse any religion or religious belief. Section 3. If any provision of this act or its 29 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 30 invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of 31
