Helmets purchased before October 1, 20 21 2007, and meeting standards of the American National Standards 22 Institute (ANSI Z 90.4 Bicycle Helmet Standards), the standards of the Snell Memorial Foundation (1984 Standard for Protective 23 Headgear for Use in Bicycling), or any other nationally 24 recognized standards for bicycle helmets adopted by the 25 department may continue to be worn by riders or passengers until 26 27 January 1, 2011. 28 "passenger" includes a child who is riding in a trailer or 29 semitrailer attached to a bicycle.

Every bicycle in use between sunset and sunrise shall 30 (8) 31 be equipped with a lamp on the front exhibiting a white light 32 visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the front and a lamp and reflector on the rear each exhibiting a red light 33 34 visible from a distance of 600 feet to the rear. A bicycle or 35 its rider may be equipped with lights or reflectors in addition 36 to those required by this section. Law enforcement officers may 37 issue a bicycle safety brochure and a verbal warning to a bicycle rider who violates this subsection. A bicycle rider who 38 violates this subsection may be issued a citation by a law 39 40 enforcement officer and assessed a fine for a pedestrian 41 violation, as provided in s. 318.18. The court shall dismiss the charge against a bicycle rider for a first violation of this 42 43 subsection upon proof of purchase and installation of the proper lighting equipment. 44
