An act relating to local government operating budgets; creating ss. 125.75 and 166.0498, F.S.; limiting annual increases in county and municipal operating budgets; providing criteria; providing exceptions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 125.75, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

Notwithstanding any other provision of general or local law, annual increases in a county's operating budget shall not exceed two times the per capita percentage change in the Consumer Price Index as provided in s. 193.155(1)(b). This limitation on annual increases in the county's operating budget may be overcome by a finding of necessity due to emergency or critical need approved by a unanimous vote of the governing body of the county.

Section 2. Section 166.0498, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

166.0498 Municipal operating budget limitations.-Notwithstanding any other provision of general or local law,
annual increases in a municipality's operating budget shall not
exceed two times the per capita percentage change in the
Consumer Price Index as provided in s. 193.155(1)(b). This
limitation on annual increases in the municipality's operating
budget may be overcome by a finding of necessity due to
