Section 1012.71, Florida Statutes, is 12 13 amended to read: 1012.71 The Florida Teachers Lead Program Stipend .--14 (1) Funding for the Florida Teachers Lead Program 15 16 Stipend shall be as determined by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act. Funds appropriated for the Florida 17 Teachers Lead Program Stipend are provided to purchase 18 19 classroom materials and supplies used in the instruction of 20 students in prekindergarten kindergarten through grade 12 of the public school system who are funded from the Florida 21 Education Finance Program, including public charter schools. 22 23 From the funds appropriated, the Commissioner of Education shall calculate an amount for each school district by 2.4 25 prorating the total of each school district's share of the total K-12 unweighted FTE student enrollment. 26 27 (2) From the funds allocated to each district, the 28 district school board shall calculate an identical amount for 29 each classroom teacher which is his or her proportionate share of the amount allocated to the district for the total number 30 31 of teachers in the district, including teachers in public 1 s0450c1p-ea00-t01 10:53 AM 03/21/07

charter schools. The district school board and each charter 1 2 school board shall provide the funds no later than September 3 30 of each year directly to each teacher as a stipend to purchase, on behalf of the school district or charter school, 4 classroom materials and supplies to be used in the instruction 5 6 of students assigned to the teacher. Each teacher shall have 7 sole discretion regarding which classroom materials and supplies best meet the needs of the students, when they are 8 9 needed, and where they are acquired. The funds expended by individual teachers shall not be subject to state or local 10 11 competitive bidding requirements. Disbursement of Florida Teachers Lead Program Stipend funds directly to each teacher 12 and to each charter school shall complete the school 13 district's expenditure of these funds. 14

(3) Each teacher shall sign a statement acknowledging 15 16 receipt of the funds, agreeing to keep receipts to show the expenditure of the funds used to purchase classroom materials 17 18 and supplies for use in the instruction of the students 19 assigned to them, and agreeing to return any unused funds by 20 the end of the regular school year. The statement to be signed and dated by each teacher for receipt of the Florida Teachers 21 Lead Program Stipend shall include the wording: "I, ... (Name 22 23 of teacher)..., am employed by the County District School Board or by the (Charter School) as a full-time 2.4 25 classroom teacher. I acknowledge that Florida Teachers Lead Program Stipend funds are appropriated by the Legislature for 26 27 the sole purpose of purchasing classroom materials and 28 supplies to be used in the instruction of students assigned to me. In accepting custody of these funds, I agree to keep 29 receipts for all expenditures. classroom materials and supplies for use with my students, it 1 2 will be my personal responsibility to pay any federal taxes 3 due on these funds. I also agree to return any unused funds to the district school board at the end of the regular school 4 year for deposit into the School Advisory Council account of 5 6 the school at which I was employed at the time of the receipt 7 of the funds or for deposit into the district's teacher lead program account of the district in which the charter school is 8 9 sponsored, as applicable."

10 (4) Florida Teachers Lead Program Stipend funds shall
11 be provided to each teacher in addition to any other funds
12 appropriated for public school operations.

(5) Any unused funds <u>that</u> which are returned to the district school board shall be deposited into the School Advisory Council account of the school at which the teacher returning the funds was employed at the time of the receipt of the funds <u>or for deposit into the district's teacher lead</u> <u>program account of the district in which the charter school is</u> sponsored, as applicable.

(6) For purposes of this section, the term "classroom 20 teacher" includes certified teachers employed by a public 21 school district or a public charter school on or before 22 23 September 1 of each year whose full-time job responsibility is the classroom instruction of students in prekindergarten 2.4 25 kindergarten through grade 12, <u>including</u> and full-time media specialists and quidance counselors who serve students in 26 prekindergarten kindergarten through grade 12 who are funded 27 28 through the Florida Education Finance Program. Only school 29 district and public charter school personnel employed in these positions are eligible for the classroom materials and supply 30 31 stipend from funds appropriated to implement the provisions of 10:53 AM 03/21/07 s0450c1p-ea00-t01
