Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

penalty; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Section 501.0116, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

501.0116 Preauthorization holds for off-line or on-line transactions for the purchase of motor fuel using a debit card.--

(1) A service station merchant must disclose in conspicuous type at the point of sale the length of time and dollar amount of any preauthorization hold that applies to an off-line debit card transaction for the purchase of motor fuel. The failure to provide such disclosure constitutes a deceptive and unfair trade practice under part II.

(2) A preauthorization hold for an on-line debit card transaction for the purchase of motor fuel may not exceed 2 hours after the time that the transaction is submitted by the

merchant or the time that the merchant receives the transactioncompletion message, whichever occurs earlier.

- (3) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. This penalty is in addition to any other civil remedies provided by law.
