29 374.975 Inland navigation districts; legislative intent.--30 (1)The Legislature hereby recognizes the continuing need for inland navigation districts to undertake programs necessary 31 to accomplish the purposes of construction, maintenance, and 32 operation of Florida's inland waterways pursuant to s. 107 of 33 the federal River and Harbor Act of 1960 (33 U.S.C. s. 577). The 34 35 inland navigation districts are authorized to use state-owned 36 submerged lands for the purposes of construction, maintenance, 37 and operation of this state's inland waterways, including the right-of-way and channel of the Intracoastal Waterway and any 38 39 other public navigation channel designated by the district.
