(2) QUALIFICATIONS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL COMPENSATION. --

(a) In addition to the compensation now paid by an
employing agency to any firefighter, every firefighter shall be
paid supplemental compensation by the employing agency when such
firefighter has complied with one of the following criteria:

37 1. Any firefighter who receives an associate degree from 38 <u>an accredited</u> a college <u>or university</u>, which degree is 39 applicable to fire department duties, as outlined in policy 40 guidelines of the division, shall be additionally compensated as 41 outlined in paragraph (3)(a).

42 2. Any firefighter, regardless of whether or not she or he 43 earned an associate degree earlier, who receives from an 44 accredited college or university a bachelor's degree, which 45 bachelor's degree is applicable to fire department duties, as 46 outlined in policy guidelines of the division, shall receive 47 compensation as outlined in paragraph (3)(b).

Any firefighter, regardless of whether or not she or he earned a bachelor's degree earlier, who receives from an accredited college or university a master's degree, which master's degree is applicable to fire department duties, as outlined in policy guidelines of the division, shall receive compensation as outlined in paragraph (3)(c).

(b) Whenever any question arises as to the eligibility of
any firefighter to receive supplemental compensation as provided
