Subsections (1), (2), (7), and (8) of 14 section 1009.701, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 15 1009.701 First Generation Matching Grant Program. --16 17 (1) The First Generation Matching Grant Program is created to enable each state university to provide donors with 18 a matching grant incentive for contributions that will create 19 grant-based student financial aid for undergraduate students 20 21 who demonstrate financial need and whose parents, as defined 22 in s. 1009.21(1), have not earned a baccalaureate degree or 23 higher. In the case of any individual who regularly resided with and received support from only one parent, an individual 2.4 whose only such parent did not complete a baccalaureate degree 25 or higher would also be eligible. 26 27 (2) Funds appropriated by the Legislature for the 2.8 program shall be allocated by the Office of Student Financial Assistance to provide \$3 for every \$1 of match private 29 contributions on a dollar for dollar basis. Contributions made 30 to a state university and pledged for the purposes of this 31 1

section are eligible for state matching funds appropriated for 1 2 this program and are not eligible for any other state matching grant program. Pledged contributions are not eligible for 3 matching prior to the actual collection of the total funds. 4 The Office of Student Financial Assistance shall reserve a 5 6 proportionate allocation of the total appropriated funds for 7 each state university on the basis of full-time equivalent 8 resident undergraduate enrollment. Funds that remain unmatched as of <u>August</u> <del>December</del> 1 shall be reallocated to state 9 universities that have remaining unmatched private 10 contributions for the program on the basis of full-time 11 12 equivalent resident undergraduate enrollment. 13 (7) Each participating institution shall report to the Office of Student Financial Assistance by the date established 14 by the office the eligible students to whom grant moneys are 15

by the office the eligible students to whom grant moneys are disbursed each academic term. Each institution shall certify to the Office of Student Financial Assistance the amount of funds disbursed to each student and shall remit to the office any undisbursed advances by June 1 of each year. Any balance at the end of any fiscal year which has been allocated to the program shall remain at the university and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the program.

23 (8) No later than November 15 July 1, each participating institution shall annually report to the 2.4 Executive Office of the Governor, the President of the Senate, 25 26 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Board of 27 Governors the eligibility requirements for recipients, the 2.8 aggregate demographics of recipients, the retention and graduation rates of recipients, and a delineation of funds 29 30 awarded to recipients in the prior academic year. 31

Section 2. For the 2007-2008 fiscal year, the sum of \$13 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Education for the First Generation Matching Grant Program pursuant to this act. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Changes the matching fund requirements for the First Generation Matching Grant Program. Clarifies funding based on enrollment of full-time resident undergraduates. Allows funds to be carried across fiscal years. Proposes an allocation of \$13 million for the 2007-2008 fiscal year.
