If a voter 14 15 registration application collected by any third-party voter registration organization is not promptly delivered to the 16 division or supervisor of elections, the individual collecting 17 18 the voter registration application, the registered agent, and 19 those individuals responsible for the day-to-day operation of 20 the third-party voter registration organization, including, if applicable, the entity's board of directors, president, vice 21 22 president, managing partner, or such other individuals engaged in similar duties or functions, shall be personally and 23 2.4 jointly and severally liable for the following fines: (a) A fine in the amount of  $\frac{$50}{$250}$  for each 25 application received by the division or the supervisor of 26 elections more than 10 days after the applicant delivered the 27 completed voter registration application to the third-party 28 29 voter registration organization or any person, entity, or agent acting on its behalf. A fine in the amount of \$500 for each 9 application received if the third-party registration 10 11 organization or person, entity, or agency acting on its behalf acted willfully. 12 13 (c) A fine in the amount of  $\frac{500}{5,000}$  for each application collected by a third-party voter registration 14 15 organization or any person, entity, or agent acting on its behalf, which is not submitted to the division or supervisor 16 of elections. A fine in the amount of \$2,500 for each 17 application not submitted if the third-party registration 18 19 organization or person, entity, or agency acting on its behalf 20 acted willfully. 21 22 The fines provided in this subsection shall be reduced by three-fourths in cases in which the third-party voter 23 2.4 registration organization has complied with subsection (1).
