Cutting, carving, injuring, mutilating, moving, displacing, or breaking off any water bottom formation or growth within the boundaries of a state park. 2. Capturing, trapping, injuring, or harassing wild animals within the boundaries of a state park. 3. Collecting plant or animal specimens within the boundaries of a state park. 4. Leaving the designated public roads with a vehicle within the boundaries of a state park. 5. Hunting within the boundaries of a state park. 6. Failing to timely pay a civil penalty imposed under this subsection. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
