22	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

24	Section 1. Effective July 1, 2008, section 489.1138,
25	Florida Statutes, is created to read:
26	489.1138 Certification of tower cranes and tower crane
27	operators
28	(1) DEFINITIONSAs used in this section:
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29 "Tower crane" means a nonmobile, power-operated (a) hoisting machine used in construction, maintenance, demolition, 30 or excavation work that has a power-operated winch, load-line, 31 32 and boom moving laterally. A tower crane is a temporary structure and is not subject to building codes or other 33 provisions of law, rule, or ordinance applicable to permanent 34 35 structures. 36 (b) "Tower crane operator" means a person engaged in 37 operating a tower crane. 38 (2) CERTIFICATION OF TOWER CRANES. -- A tower crane may be 39 operated in this state only if it meets the applicable standards of the American National Standards Institute/American Society of 40 41 Mechanical Engineers (ANSI/ASME) or the applicable standards of the Power Crane and Shovel Association (PCSA). A tower crane is 42 43 deemed to meet such standards only if it has been certified by 44 an organization determined by the department to offer a certification program that meets the currently applicable 45 ANSI/ASME standards or the accreditation requirements of the 46 47 National Commission for Certifying Agencies. This subsection 48 applies to tower cranes installed or erected on or after July 1, 49 2008. 50 CERTIFICATION OF TOWER CRANE OPERATORS. -- A person may (3) operate a tower crane on a construction project only if he or 51 52 she is certified as a crane operator by the National Commission 53 for the Certification of Crane Operators or any other 54 organization determined by the department to offer an equivalent 55 testing and certification program that meets the requirements of 56 the ANSI/ASME current applicable standard or the accreditation Page 2 of 4

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57 requirements of the National Commission for Certifying Agencies. 58 (4) DUTIES OF CONTRACTORS. -- A contractor registered or certified under this part shall only employ or contract for the 59 60 services of tower crane operators who have met the certification 61 requirements of subsection (3). 62 (5) PENALTIES.--Any person licensed under this part who 63 intentionally violates subsection (2) or subsection (3) is subject to discipline pursuant to ss. 455.227 and 489.129. 64 65 (6) OPERATION OF TOWER CRANES BY TRAINEES UNDER SUPERVISION. -- Notwithstanding the certification requirements of 66 67 this section, a person undergoing training for the purpose of qualifying for tower crane operator certification pursuant to 68 this section may operate a tower crane if such person is under 69 70 the direct supervision of a tower crane operator who holds a 71 current and valid certification to operate the tower crane 72 operated by such person. (7) RULES.--The department may adopt rules pursuant to ss. 73 74 120.536(1) and 120.54 necessary to implement this section. 75 Section 2. Section 489.1139, Florida Statutes, is created 76 to read: 77 489.1139 Preemption.--The regulation of tower cranes and 78 tower crane operators is expressly preempted to the state, and 79 no county, municipality, or other political subdivision shall enact or enforce any ordinance relating to matters within the 80 scope of this section and s. 489.1138. 81 82 Section 3. If any law amended by this act was also amended by a law enacted during the 2007 Regular Session or a 2007 83 special session of the Legislature, such laws shall be construed 84 Page 3 of 4

86	Legislature, and full effect shall be given to each if possible.
87	Section 4. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this
88	act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
