Subsections (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5) of 6 section 210.02, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 7 210.02 Cigarette tax imposed; collection .--8 An excise or privilege tax, in addition to all other (1)9 taxes of every kind imposed by law, is imposed upon the sale, receipt, purchase, possession, consumption, handling, 10 distribution, and use of cigarettes in this state, in the 11 following amounts, except as hereinafter otherwise provided, for 12 cigarettes of standard dimensions: 13 14 (a) Upon all cigarettes weighing not more than 3 pounds per thousand, 50 16.95 mills on each cigarette. 15

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(b) Upon all cigarettes weighing more than 3 pounds per thousand and not more than 6 inches long, <u>133.9</u> <del>33.9</del> mills on each cigarette.

(c) Upon all cigarettes weighing more than 3 pounds per thousand and more than 6 inches long, <u>267.8</u> <del>67.8</del> mills on each cigarette.

(2) The description of cigarettes contained in paragraphs
(a), (b), and (c) of subsection (1) are hereby declared to be
standard as to dimensions for taxing purposes as provided in
this law and should any cigarette be received, purchased,
possessed, sold, offered for sale, given away, or used of a size
other than of standard dimensions, the same shall be taxed at
the rate of 4.16 1.41 cents on each such cigarette.

(3) When cigarettes as described in paragraph (1)(a) are packed in varying quantities of 20 cigarettes or less, except manufacturer's free samples authorized under s. 210.04(9), the following rate shall govern:
