

## CHAMBER ACTION

Senate House Comm: RCS 4/1/2008

The Committee on Banking and Insurance (Lawson) recommended the following amendment:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Senator Les Miller Act."

Section 2. Section 627.64091, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

627.64091 Coverage for prostate cancer screening. --

(1) A health insurance policy providing coverage to a man 40 years of age or older must provide coverage for annual screening for prostate cancer for such man in accordance with the quidelines for the early detection of prostate cancer set forth in the National Comprehensive Cancer Network guidelines.

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- (2) The coverage for prostate cancer screening shall consist, at a minimum, of the following tests:
  - (a) Prostate-specific antigen blood test; and
  - (b) Digital rectal examination.
- (3) If a licensed medical practitioner recommends that an insured undergo a prostate-specific antigen blood test, coverage may not be denied because that person previously had a digital rectal exam and the exam results were negative.
- (4) The benefits required by this section do not limit diagnostic benefits otherwise allowable under the policy.
- Section 3. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 627.6515, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
  - 627.6515 Out-of-state groups.--
- (2) Except as otherwise provided in this part, this part does not apply to a group health insurance policy issued or delivered outside this state under which a resident of this state is provided coverage if:
- The policy provides the benefits specified in ss. 627.419, 627.6574, 627.6575, 627.6579, 627.6612, 627.66121, 627.66122, 627.6613, 627.6614, 627.667, 627.6675, 627.6691, and 627.66911.
- Section 4. Section 627.6614, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
  - 627.6614 Coverage for prostate cancer screening. --
- (1) A group health insurance policy that provides coverage to a man 40 years of age or older must provide coverage for annual screening for prostate cancer for such man in accordance with the guidelines for the early detection of prostate cancer set forth in the National Comprehensive Cancer Network quidelines.

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- 47 (2) The coverage for prostate cancer screening shall 48 consist, at a minimum, of the following tests: 49 (a) Prostate-specific antigen blood test; and (b) Digital rectal examination. 50 51 (3) If a licensed medical practitioner recommends that an
  - insured undergo a prostate-specific antigen blood test, coverage may not be denied because that person previously had a digital rectal exam and the exam results were negative.
  - (4) The benefits required by this section do not limit diagnostic benefits otherwise allowable under the policy.
  - Section 5. Subsection (41) is added to section 641.31, Florida Statutes, to read:
    - 641.31 Health maintenance contracts.--
  - (41) (a) A health maintenance organization contract that provides coverage to a man 40 years of age or older must provide coverage for annual screening for prostate cancer for such man in accordance with the guidelines for the early detection of prostate cancer set forth in the National Comprehensive Cancer Network guidelines.
  - (b) The coverage for prostate cancer screening shall consist, at a minimum, of the following tests:
    - 1. Prostate-specific antigen blood test; and
    - 2. Digital rectal examination.
  - (c) If a licensed medical practitioner recommends that a subscriber undergo a prostate-specific antigen blood test, coverage may not be denied because that person previously had a digital rectal exam and the exam results were negative.
  - The benefits required by this section do not limit diagnostic benefits otherwise allowable under the contract.



Section 6. The Legislature finds that the provisions of this act fulfill an important state interest.

Section 7. This act shall take effect January 1, 2009, and applies to policies and contracts issued or renewed on or after that date.

An act relating to health insurance; creating the "Senator Les Miller Act"; creating ss. 627.64091 and 627.6614, F.S., and amending s. 641.31, F.S.; requiring that health insurance policies, group health insurance policies, and health maintenance contracts provide coverage for an annual screening for prostate cancer for men of a specified age or older; providing requirements for the screening; providing that coverage for prostate cancer screening does not limit diagnostic benefits otherwise allowed under the policy; amending s. 627.6515, F.S.; providing for the benefit requirement to apply to a group health insurance policy issued or delivered outside the state; providing a finding that the act fulfills an important state interest; providing for application of the act; providing an effective date.
