Section 2. Section 624.1265, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

624.1265 Nonprofit religious organization exemption; authority; notice. --

(1) Any nonprofit religious organization that qualifies under Title 26, s. 501 of the Internal Revenue Code; that limits its participants to members of the same religion; that acts as an organizational clearinghouse for information between participants who have financial, physical, or medical needs and participants having the ability to pay for the benefit of those participants who have financial, physical, or medical needs; that provides for the financial or medical needs of a participant through payments

directly from one participant to another; and that suggests amounts that participants may voluntarily give with no assumption of risk or promise to pay among the participants or between the participants and the organization are not subject to any requirements of the Florida Insurance Code.

- This section does not prevent the organization described in subsection (1) from establishing qualifications of participation relating to the health of a prospective participant, prevent a participant from limiting the financial or medical needs that may be eligible for payment, or prevent the organization from canceling the membership of a participant if such participant indicates his or her unwillingness to participate by failing to make a payment to another participant within 60 days.
- The organization described in subsection (1) shall (3) provide each prospective participant in the organizational clearinghouse written notice that the organization is not an insurance company, that membership is not offered through an insurance company, and that the organization is not subject to the regulatory requirements or consumer protections of the Florida Insurance Code.
