Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Subsection (1) of section 403.506, Florida 403.506 Applicability, thresholds, and certification .--The provisions of this act shall apply to an any electrical power plant as defined in s. 403.503(13) herein, except that the provisions of this act do shall not apply to an any electrical power plant or steam generating plant of less than 75 megawatts in capacity or to a any substation to be constructed as part of an associated transmission line unless the applicant has elected to apply for certification of such plant or substation under this act. The provisions of this act do shall not apply to any unit capacity expansions expansion of 75 35 megawatts or less, in the aggregate, of an existing exothermic reaction cogeneration electrical generating facility unit that was exempt from this act when it was originally built; however, this exemption does shall not apply if the facility unit uses oil or natural gas for purposes other than unit startup. 30 maximum electrical generator rating of an any existing electrical 31 power plant may not be undertaken after October 1, 1973, without 32 first obtaining certification in the manner as herein provided in this act, except that this act does shall not apply to an any 33 such electrical power plant that which is presently operating or 34 35 under construction or that which has, upon the effective date of chapter 73-33, Laws of Florida, applied for a permit or 36 37 certification under requirements in force before prior to the 38 effective date of such act.
