(b) No elected or appointed member of a local government council or advisory committee shall, directly or indirectly, solicit any contribution on behalf of a candidate from an individual who is participating in a pending matter before the council or advisory committee. For purposes of this paragraph, "pending matter" means any quasi-judicial or other proceeding, application, request for a ruling or other determination, or other particular action involving a specific party or parties. The prohibition in this paragraph shall not apply to the members of a governing body of a district, county, or municipality regardless of whether such members are acting in an elected or appointed capacity.
