(b) No elected or appointed member of a local government council or advisory committee acting in a quasi-judicial matter, including, but not limited to, code enforcement, zoning, or land use decisions, shall, directly or indirectly, solicit any contribution on behalf of a candidate from an individual who is participating in a matter pending before the council or advisory committee. For purposes of this paragraph, "matter" means any quasi-judicial or other proceeding, application, request for a ruling or other determination, or other particular action involving a specific party or parties. This prohibition shall not apply to the governing body of a district, county, or municipality.
