Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 394.4572, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

394.4572 Screening of mental health personnel .--

(1) (a) The department and the Agency for Health Care 10 11 Administration shall require employment screening for mental 12 health personnel using the standards for level 2 screening set forth in chapter 435. "Mental health personnel" includes all 13 program directors, professional clinicians, staff members, and 14 15 volunteers working in public or private mental health programs and facilities who have direct contact with unmarried patients 16 17 under the age of 18 years. For purposes of this chapter,

18 employment screening of mental health personnel shall also 19 include, but is not limited to, employment screening as provided 20 under chapter 435.

(b) Students in the health care professions who are interning in a mental health facility licensed under chapter 395, where the primary purpose of the facility is not the treatment of minors, are exempt from the fingerprinting and screening requirements, provided they are under direct supervision in the actual physical presence of a licensed health care professional.

27 (c) Mental health personnel working in a facility licensed under chapter 395 who have less than 15 hours per week of direct 28 29 contact with patients or who are health care professionals 30 licensed by the Agency for Health Care Administration or a board 31 thereunder are exempt from the fingerprinting and screening 32 requirements, except for persons working in mental health 33 facilities where the primary purpose of the facility is the 34 treatment of minors.

35 (d) (c) A volunteer who assists on an intermittent basis for 36 less than 40 hours per month is exempt from the fingerprinting 37 and screening requirements, provided the volunteer is under 38 direct and constant supervision by persons who meet the screening 39 requirements of paragraph (a).
