15 459.0152 Specialties.--An osteopathic physician licensed 16 under this chapter may not hold himself or herself out as a 17 board-certified specialist unless the osteopathic physician has successfully completed the requirements for certification by the 18 American Osteopathic Association or the Accreditation Council on 19 20 Graduate Medical Education and is certified as a specialist by a 21 certifying agency approved by the board. An osteopathic 22 physician licensed under this chapter who completes his or her board certification after January 1, 2009, may not hold himself 23 24 or herself out as a board-certified emergency osteopathic 25 physician unless the osteopathic physician has received formal 26 recognition as a specialist from a recognized agency approved by 27 the board and has completed a residency training program in emergency medicine which is approved by the American Osteopathic 28 29 Association or the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical
