- EXEMPTIONS. -- The following vessels are exempt from provisions of subsection (1):
- (a) A vessel that is Vessels owned and operated by Sea Explorer or Sea Scout units of the Boy Scouts of America, the Girl Scouts of America, the Florida Association of Christian Child Caring Agencies, Inc., Safe Harbor Haven, Inc., or the Associated Marine Institutes, Inc., and its affiliates.
- (b) An are antique vessel vessels as defined in paragraph (2) (a) are exempt from the provisions of subsection (1).
- (c) A non-motor-powered sailing vessel that is owned by a nonprofit entity and used exclusively for teaching boating
