Section 66. (1) School districts are encouraged to enter into partnerships with local businesses for purposes of mentorship opportunities, the development of employment options and additional funding sources, and other mutual benefits.

(2) As a pilot program through June 30, 2011, the Palm Beach County school district may recognize its business partners by publicly displaying such business partners' names on school district property in the unincorporated areas. "Project Graduation" and athletic sponsorships are examples of appropriate recognition. The district shall make every effort to display its



business partners' names in a manner that is consistent with the county standards for uniformity in size, color, and placement of signs. If the provisions of this section are inconsistent with the county ordinances or regulations relating to signs in the unincorporated areas or inconsistent with chapter 125, chapter 166, or chapter 479, Florida Statutes, the provisions of this section prevail.
