13	for any single school year by an eligible nonprofit scholarship-
14	funding organization from eligible contributions shall <u>be for</u>
15	total costs authorized under subparagraph (6)(d)1., not to exceed
16	the following annual limits:

17	<u>a.</u> 1. Three thousand seven hundred fifty dollars for a
18	scholarship awarded to a student enrolled in an eligible private
19	school for the 2008-2009 state fiscal year. Beginning in the
20	2009-2010 state fiscal year, the State Board of Education shall,
21	by rule, adjust the maximum amounts for the scholarship awards
22	under this sub-subparagraph to reflect 60 percent of the
23	unweighted FEFP student funding amount established in the annual
24	appropriations act for the ensuing state fiscal year. However,
25	the increase in the maximum amounts for a scholarship award under
26	this sub-subparagraph may not exceed \$200 annually. The annually
27	adjusted amounts shall be rounded downward to the nearest dollar.
28	<u>b.</u> 2. Five hundred dollars for a scholarship awarded to a
29	student enrolled in a Florida public school that is located
30	outside the district in which the student resides or in a lab
31	school as defined in s. 1002.32.
32	2. Beginning in the 2009-2010 state fiscal year, the amount
33	of an annual premium payment by an eligible nonprofit
34	scholarship-funding organization from eligible contributions
35	shall be \$200 for costs authorized under subparagraph (6)(d)2.
36	provided to a student who takes the statewide assessments
37	pursuant to s. 1008.22 if at least 95 percent of the private
38	school's eligible scholarship students participate in the
39	statewide assessments.
