28 standards and prescribe procedures and timeframes for bacteriological sampling of beach waters. 29 30 (3) (2) The department may issue health advisories if the quality of beach waters fails to meet standards established by 31 32 the department. The issuance of health advisories related to the results of bacteriological sampling of beach waters is preempted 33 34 to the state. When the Department of Health issues a health 35 advisory against swimming in beach waters on the basis of 36 finding elevated levels of fecal coliform or enterococci 37 bacteria in a water sample, the department shall contemporaneously notify the relevant local government and the 38 local office of the Department of Environmental Protection, 39 40 which shall promptly investigate wastewater treatment facilities within 1 mile of the affected beach to determine if a facility 41 42 experienced an incident that may have contributed to the 43 contamination. Upon completion, the Department of Environmental Protection shall notify the relevant local government in writing 44 or by electronic correspondence of the results of its 45 46 investigation.
